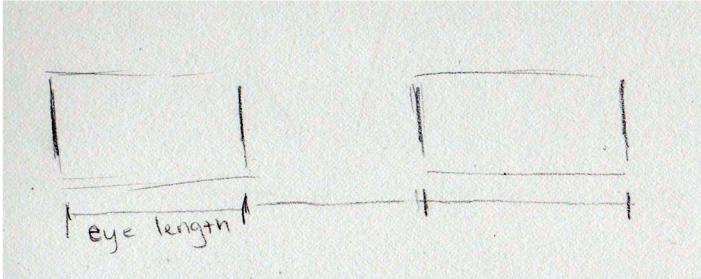
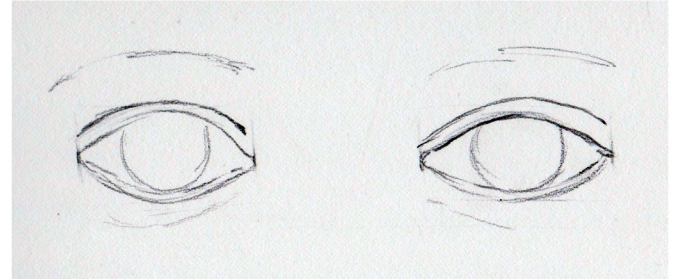


# 5 Step Cheat Sheet to Drawing Eyes



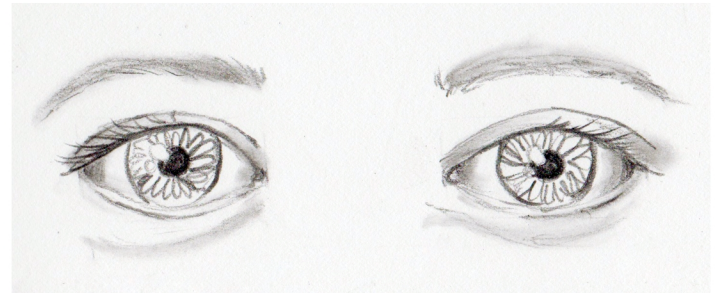
1. Start with two boxes of the same length. They should be one length apart from each other as well.



2. In each box, draw an oval. Draw an upper and lower lid on each oval (make sure the bottom lid is much thinner than the top lid), and a partial circle in the center of each oval. Draw an arc over the top of each eye to be a guide for the eyebrows.



3. Draw a pupil in each eye, as well as a shape for a highlight or two in each eye. Darken the lines of the upper eyelid and the outline of the iris (the colored part of the eye). Add a few more hairs to the eyebrows.



4. Fill in the pupils, add some spokes in the irises, and add shading to the corners of the eyes and eyebrows. Add some shading to the upper eyelid and add a few eyelashes as well, but be careful not to add too many. One pencil stroke per eyelash.

5. Blend the spokes into an even tone with a few lines in the iris, then use the kneaded eraser to pull out a highlight over the surface of the eye. Pull out a few small hairs in the eyebrows with the kneaded eraser, then re-draw some darker ones for contrast. Add some small eyelashes to the lower lid, and finish by adding and blending the tone of the skin around the eyes.
